

CHIPBOARD signs

Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

supplies:

- Small, Medium, and Large chipboard word cut outs
- Rusty twisted wire
- 2 1/2 inch rusty hearts
- 2 1/8 inch rusty hearts
- 3 different colors of textured Patio Paint
- Wire cutter
- Paint brush

Directions:

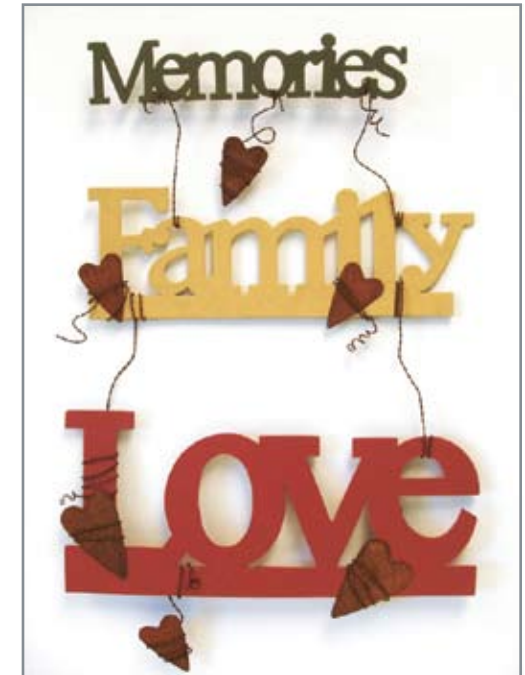
1. Begin by painting both sides of the word cut outs with one layer of your desired paint color.

2. After your paint has fully dried, sponge on one more layer of the same color for maximum texture.

3. Using the twisted rusty wire attach your words to one another. This can be done by twisting the wire around the letters. (You will need to cut the wire into two foot sections.) If your wire is too much longer than that it can get difficult to work with.

4. Using smaller sections of your wire, wrap the hearts onto different letters.

5. When hanging your piece remember to hang from the middle word. The small word may not be strong enough to hold the weight.
