

Glue Foil frames

Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

supplies:

Black Foil Canvas Frame:

- 8x8 canvas
- Ribbon
- Black acrylic paint
- glue foil
- embossing machine (Cuttlebug)
- craft iron
- sandpaper
- pop dots

Hammered Copper Frame:

- 8x8 wood frame
- Black acrylic Frame
- glue foil
- craft iron
- craft knife
- hammer



Directions:

Black Foil Canvas Frame:

1. Paint the entire canvas black using acrylic paint. Both front and back.
2. Cut glue foil into 2"x4" strips, and run through an embossing machine. We used the Cuttlebug by Cricut.
3. Wrap the embossed glue foil strips around the back side of the canvas and adhere using a heat source. We used a craft iron.
4. Paint a layer of black acrylic paint over the top of the embossed metal. Let dry completely. Then lightly sand the paint off so the raised/embossed metal shows through.
5. Cut a piece of ribbon and glue along the inside of the frame.
6. Cut a picture to size and mount on cardstock. Tie a bow and glue to the corner of picture. Put a few foam pop dots behind picture to add dimension.

Hammered Copper Frame:

1. Paint the edges and back of the wood frame black using acrylic paint. Let dry.
2. Center the glue foil over the front of the frame.
3. Adhere using a craft iron.
4. Once the glue foil has cooled, cut off excess glue foil with a craft knife, Iron the glue foil around the edges.
5. Use the craft knife to cut an "X" in the frame opening, then wrap the glue foil around the opening edges and iron into place.
6. Once the frame has cooled, use a hammer and distress the foil.
7. Rub the black paint into the dents in the foil & wipe off excess with paper towel.
