Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

supplies

- Rustic Star
- Three or more patterned papers
- One 11x18 white paper
- Mod Podge
- Foam Brush
- Brayer or dry cloth
- Distress Ink
- Foam dauber



Directions:

1. Take a piece of white 11X18 paper and lay over one corner of the star and rub the edges so the corner leaves an imprint on to the paper. This half of one star corner will be your template.
2. Cut the imprint out and then cut the star corner template in half (vertically). Trace the half template five times onto different pattern papers. Turn template over and trace five more times onto patterned papers. Cut out traced images. Always lay your paper choices out before gluing and rotate your patterned images.
3. Apply Mod Podge to one section of the star at a time with a foam brush. Then adhere cut out pieces to each of the star panels, alternating papers to your own taste. Using the brush or dry cloth (I found that using a credit card works best!), smooth out the bubbles and edges of each panel.
4. After all the paper is adhered and smoother, apply distress ink to the edges and creases of the paper with the foam dauber.
5. Optional: tie a bow to the top of the star
