Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

supplies

- 6x12x2 styrofoam
- decorative paper
- hot glue
- paint or inkpad
- E-6000 glue
- sawtooth picture hangers
- sheet of antiqued tin (optional)

directions:

1. Measure and trim paper so it wraps around top edge, front and bottom edge of styrofoam. Cut separate pieces to cover the two side edges of styrofoam.
2. Score paper where you would like it to bend around styrofoam. Use hot glue to adhere the paper.
3. Brush paint or ink pad on edges of cube to create a distressed look. Use as little or as much as you'd like.
4. Optional: Cut tin into strips and use as decorative corners. Adhere to cube using heavy duty glue (ex: E-6000.)
5. Secure sawtooth picture hangers onto back of cube using nails provided.



Gerbera CUBES

supplies

- 2 - styrofoam blocks
- 16 - green gerbera silk flowers
- 8 - white gerbera silk flowers
- hot glue

directions:

1. Use hot glue to adhere flower heads onto styrofoam cube in desired pattern. Leave bottom open so it will sit flat.

Hint: if the styrofoam is still visible at the corners - dab a bit of glue onto petals of flower and glue to the flower next to it.
