## supplies:

- 1 1/2" Small Clay Pots- 2
- Paint: Brown, White, Black, Orange, Gold and Green
- Pipe Cleaners: Green and Brown
- Wooden Ovals, 2-inch
- Doll Head Beads, 1 1/4 inch, 2
- Chenille stem, black and brown
- Clay pot, 1 1/2 inch, 2
- Small Pom-poms red and green
- Small Red Bead



## Directions:

### FOR SNOWMAN:

1. Use the flat brush to paint one clay pot and one doll head with White paint. Allow the paint to dry.
2. Glue the doll head to the bottom of the clay pot to make the snowman's body.
3. Use the liner brush to paint a scarf around the snowman's neck with Green paint. Allow the paint to dry.
4. Use the liner brush to make eyes and a mouth with Black paint. Allow the paint to dry. Use the liner brush to make a nose with orange paint. Allow the paint to dry. Use the liner brush to paint buttons in black and stripes on the scarf with gold paint. Allow the paint to dry.
5. To make the ear muffs cut a 2 1/2-inch piece of pipe cleaners with wire cutters. Glue each end of the pipe cleaners to the sides of the snowman's head. Cover each end of the wire with a small green pom-pom.

6. To make arms cut two 2-inch pieces of the brown chenille stem. Fold one piece in half and twist it to the other piece to make fingers. Repeat to make the other arm. Glue the arms to each side of the snowman.

### FOR REINDEER:

1. Use the flat brush to paint the pot, large circle and doll head with Brown paint. Allow the paint to dry.
2. Glue the doll head to the bottom of the clay pot to make the reindeer's body.
3. Use the flat brush to paint the small bead with red paint. Allow the paint to dry and glue the small bead to the center of the nose.
4. Use the flat brush to paint the wooden sign with green paint. Allow the paint to dry. Use the flat brush to paint the two small wooden circles with Black paint. Allow the paint to dry.
5. Use the liner brush to make eyes and a mouth with green paint. Allow the paint to dry. Use the liner brush to write HAPPY HOLIDAYS on the sign with gold paint. Allow the paint to dry.
6. Glue the wooden sign to the front of the reindeer. Glue the small wooden circles to the front of the sign for hooves.
7. Cut two 4-inch pieces and four 2-inch pieces of the black chenille stem. Fold the 2-inch pieces in half and twist it to the longer pieces to make antlers. Glue the antlers to the top to the reindeer's head.

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
