

September: Summer Captured

supplies:

- 10 Photos (horizontal orientation) cropped to 2-3/4" x 4"
- Cosmo Cricket Blackboard Album - "Jack"
- October Afternoon 12x12 paper
1 sheet of each:
 - Detours: Walk in the Park
 - Detours: Dirt Roads
 - Detours: Picnic Basket
 - Detours: Gazebo
 - Detours: Die Cut Sheet
 - Daydream: Freshly Mown Lawn
- Clear alpha stamps & acrylic block
- Scenic Route "Snapshot" clear stamp set & acrylic block
- Memories ink pad - Black
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Corner Rounder
- Adhesive
- Trimmer
- Black Marker
- 9" Ribbon



Directions:

1. Cut a 1" strip from each sheet, then cut strips into 3-1/4" lengths.
 2. Cut four 3-1/4" x 4-1/2" rectangles from Daydream: Freshly Mown Lawn, round corners of all rectangles.
 3. Cut two 3-1/4" x 4-1/2" rectangles from each remaining sheet of 12x12 paper, round corners of all rectangles.
 4. Cut one 2-3/8" x 3-3/4" rectangle from Detours: Gazebo
 5. Adhere the rectangles to each page of the album. The album has 6 pages, the pattern used on the front of each page is also used on the back of each page in this order - Detours: Picnic Basket, Detours: Gazebo, Daydream: Freshly Mown Lawn, reverse side of Freshly Mown Lawn, Detours: Dirt Roads, and Detours: Walk in the Park.
 6. Stamp camera a little off to the right on the grid side of the Gazebo rectangle that does not have rounded corners. Using clear alpha stamps, spell out words "summer captured" on acrylic block and stamp below camera.
 7. Using a Glue Dot adhere button to lens of stamped camera, and tie ribbon around on left side, trimming off any extra, then adhere to front page.
 8. Place pages in order. Start on inside cover on the ring-side of page, measure in about an inch from edge of paper rectangle and adhere 1" x 3-1/4" strips to each page except back cover.
 9. Use one of the 1" strips of the Gazebo and cut down to 2-5/8" in length. On the grid side toward bottom center, stamp "Caught on Film" and adhere to back cover.
 10. Adhere photos to each page. Punch out journaling blocks (cut to size) and tabs from die cut sheet, adhere to pages after journaling on them.
