supplies

- Multi-Photo Clock (9-3x3 squares)
- double-sided tape
- 4 - photos (3"x3" or smaller)
- Walnut Stain - Distress Ink
- hole punch
- 1/16" 3-D Dots
- My Minds Eye - 29th Street Market
 - Fresh "Beauty" asst. die-cut sheet (1)
 - Fresh "Mother" asst. die-cut sheet (1)
 - Fresh "Beauty" flower die-cut (1)
 - Fresh "Outdoors" acetate leaves (2)
 - Fresh "Outdoors" Natural Print/Tadpole paper (1)
 - Fresh "Outdoors" Spring Greens/Sprout paper (1)
 - Fresh "Brothers" Playground Stripes/Sidewalk Chalk paper (1)
 - Fresh "Mother" Mama's Curtains/Brunette paper (1)



Directions:

1. Cut 2 - 3"x3" squares out of each of the 4 papers.
2. Take small circle die-cut from Beauty asst. sheet and ink edges. Punch a hole in the center. Adhere in center of clock square with double-sided tape. (You will need to remove the hands of the clock to do this.)
3. From Mother asst. sheet, cut down "nobody like a mother" die-cut & ink edges.
4. Have photos shrunk down to fit into 3x3 squares. Use scraps of paper to mat the photos & to make photo corners. Ink edges.
5. Square 1 & 9 have Fresh "Brothers" paper. Attach photos with 1/16" 3-D Dots.
6. Square 2 & 8 have Fresh "Outdoors" paper-Natural Print. Attach "natural" die-cut in one square and "nobody like a mother" die-cut towards bottom of another.
7. Square 3 & 7 have Fresh "Outdoors" Spring Greens paper. Take squares 2 & 3, 6 & 7: Lay side by side and adhere acetate leaves over 2 & 3, 6 & 7. Cut apart.
8. Adhere photos to squares 3 & 7 with 1/16" 3-D Dots.
9. Square 4 & 6 have Fresh "Mother" Mama's Curtains paper. Ink Edges of flower die-cut & place over squares 4 & 6. Cut die-cut between the 2 squares.
10. Place 3x3 squares in frames.
