Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

Supplies:

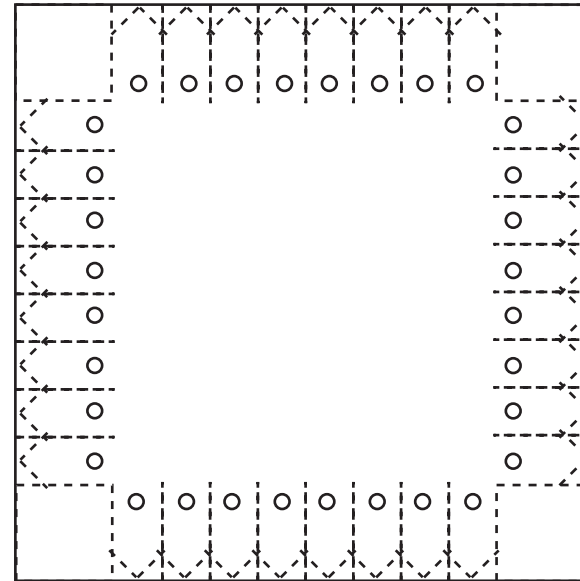
- Single piece of fleece about 3 inches longer and wider than you want your finished size to be.
- Scissors
- Measuring device



Directions:

1. Cut a 3 inch square out of each corner of your fleece.

2. Cut 1 1/2 inch wide strips on all sides. The strips should be 3 inches long. Make sure to cut each end of the strip to a point.



3. Poke a small hole in each strip near the inside of your cut. We used an awl. See diagram.

4. Pull point through hole from left side to right side of fleece. It pulls very hard so you may want to use pliers. Do not cut your hole bigger or pull too tight.
