

Rag Time BABY FLEECE BLANKET

Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

Supplies:

- 1/3 yard of two prints and two solid fleeces (4 total)

Directions:

1. Cut four 12 x 12" pieces from each strip.
2. Sew them in diagonal rows so that like pieces only touch each other from the diagonal starting in the bottom left and ending in the top right, as in the diagram below.

1	2	3	4
2	3	4	1
3	4	1	2
4	1	2	3



3. Sew rows across using a 1" seam allowance, making sure that all the seams face the front.
4. Sew around edges with a 1" seam.
5. Clip all edges close to but not crossing thread lines.

TO MAKE A LARGE QUILT

- Get 1 yard instead of 1/3 yard of each fabric.
- Lay out 6 rows across and 8 down.
- Follow directions as above to complete the quilt.
